Save up to 30% by purchasing your tickets in advance!

The prices listed above are full, gate prices. Buy your tickets in advance and they will be discounted from **20% to 30%** depending on the total number of tickets you purchase. The discount structure is based on the following:
 Buy **1 to 5** tickets in any combination - **20%** off ticket price,
 Buy **6 to 12** tickets in any combination - **25%** off tickets.
 Buy **13 or more** tickets in any combination - **30%** off tickets.
Service Charges will only be added for phone-in orders (add \$4 per order), or if you request that your tickets be mailed to you (add \$4).
 Advance discounts apply to daily festival tickets only. They do not apply to workshop registrations, camping, or vehicle parking fees.

 For your best value on ticket purchases, you should buy on-line by visiting www.kerrvillefolkfestival.com.
 For phone orders*, call the festival office at (830) 257-3600 during business hours Monday through Friday.
 Prices listed include sales tax and most service fees. Phone in orders are subject to a \$4 service fee per order
No refunds or exchanges on tickets for any reason.

GATE HOURS
 The Kennedy Theater (Mainstage) is open 6pm - Midnight on weekends. The Campground Gate is open 24-hrs. Tickets at the gate are available 24-hrs Fri-Sun and unavailable (closed) from 12am-8am on weekdays. Will Call Tickets will not be available when Tickets is closed.

CHILDREN'S PRICES
 Children under 12 are admitted FREE when accompanied by ticket holding adult. Children 12 and over must have a ticket. **No one under 18 may be admitted without parent or guardian.**
CAMPGROUND FEES
 Tent camping fees are \$5 per night per person. Tent camping fees are **WAIVED** if you hold or purchase tickets for 3 or more consecutive days. **You must have festival tickets and/or a wristband in order to camp or enter the campgrounds during the festival! Wristbands are required after 6 PM.**

Vehicles in the Campgrounds: To maximize space for tents, we restrict the number of vehicles in the campgrounds. To do this we charge **\$20 per day for transportation vehicles in the campgrounds** (refundable, \$20 two-hour unloading permits will be available at the campground gate). Parking fees in the parking lot are \$3 per day per vehicle, payable at the gate.

VEHICLE PARKING FEE
 There is a **\$3 per day per vehicle** charge for parking in the festival parking lots. All parking fees are payable at the festival ticket booth or parking lot entrance.

RV SITES
 There are a limited number of RV hook-up sites on the ranch. Sites available at the time of this publication are \$25 per night and have water & electricity only (no sewer). Sites are for pop-ups, vans, and trailers up to 24 feet long. Call (830) 257-3600.
SLEEPER VEHICLES
 Obvious sleeper vehicles such as vans, pick-ups with camper shells, trailers and RVs (without RV site reservations), etc. can purchase a sleeper vehicle permit for a single \$20 fee upon entry. If the vehicle doesn't leave the campground, no additional camping fees will be required. \$20 will be charged for **EACH** re-entry to the campgrounds.
